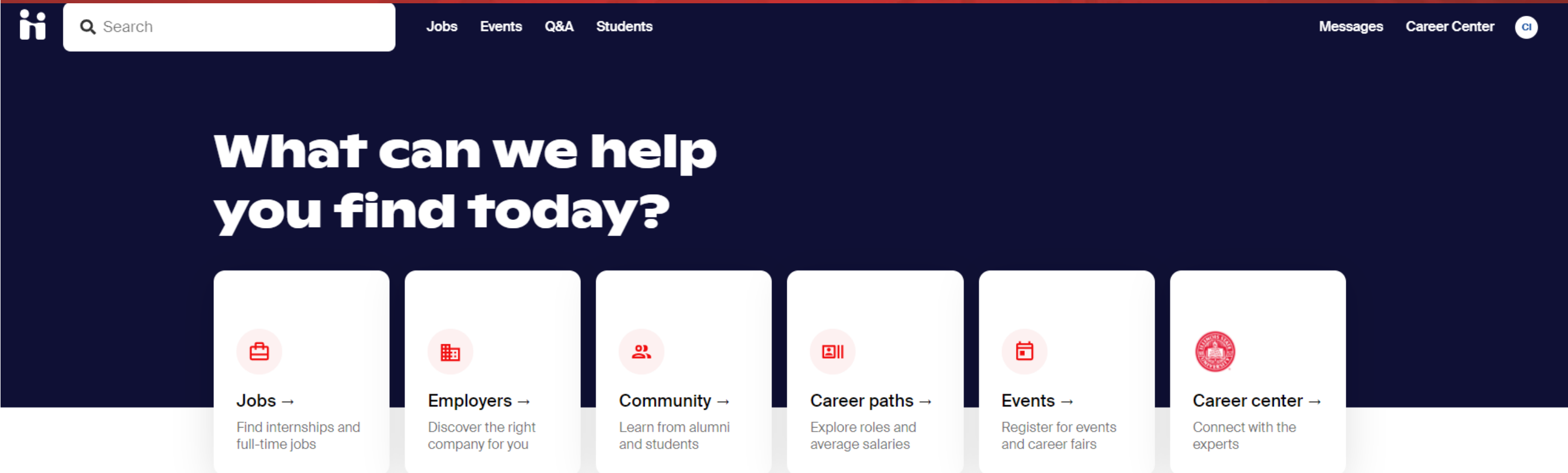

# Can a part-time job turn into an Internship (for credit)?

You may be able to earn up to 3 hours of marketing elective credits (and/or up to 3 general university credits) IF your part-time job meets all of the following requirements:

- ✓ 60 hours needed per credit hour
- ✓ Minimum of 60% marketing-specific training
- ✓ Internship packet (paperwork) filed, reviewed, and approved prior to beginning of internship
- ✓ Your internship coordinator (either Dr. Ishida or Dr. Hunter) approves the paperwork you submit
