 - a. One set of transcripts per institution
 - b. Statement of purpose outlining your interest in economics, research and career goals
 - c. Curriculum Vitae/Resume
 - d. Three (3) academic letters of recommendation
- 4. Use the following Test Score Reporting Codes for the GRE and TOEFL:

- 5. Examine <u>funding opportunities</u> and apply for funding by our published deadlines to be considered for financial support (separate decision from the admissions decision).
