## PREFACE

## August 2011

The twelfth annual *Graduate School Data Book* includes a collection of information designed to answer frequently asked questions about Illinois State University's Graduate School. The information for Fiscal Year 2011 is organized in major sections: overview, programs, degrees conferred and resources, reference and definitions. An appendix offers information on the interpretative data used to score reports and an institutional profile from the Survey of Earned Doctorates.

Illinois State University began offering master's degree programs in 1943; doctoral work was introduced in 1962. In Fiscal Year 2011, the University offered 43 master's programs (including the Master of Fine Arts and the Master of Business Administration), nine doctoral programs (Biological Sciences, Curriculum and Instruction, Educational Administration, English Studies, Mathematics Education, School Psychology, Special Education, Nursing and Doctor of Audiology), a Specialist in School Psychology, and nine graduate-level certificates. *Educating Illinois 2008-2014: Priorities for Illinois' First Public University* presents Illinois State University's mission, vision, values and goals. *Educating Illinois* identifies a series of strategies for advancing the University's goals. # **REFERENCE** University Definitions

Admission Grade Point Average: To be admitted to a master's degree program, a student must have at least a 2.8 grade point average, on a four point scale, for the last 60 hours of undergraduate work.

**Census Day**: The University's official date for enrollment. The first day of class following the 10<sup>th</sup> day of class in each semester.

Certificates: Illinois State University currently offers three types of certificates at the graduate level:

- Graduate Certificate (GC): Requires a minimum of nine but no more than 17 semester hours of graduate courses beyond the bachelor's degree. This type of certificate is not approved/reviewed by the Illinois Board of Higher Education (IBHE).
- Post-Baccalaureate Graduate Certificate (PBC): Requires a minimum of 18 semester hours of graduate courses beyond the baccalaureate degree, but less than required for a masters' degree. This type of certificate is approved/reviewed by the IBHE.
- Post-Master's Graduate Certificate (PMC): Requires a minimum of 24 semester hours of graduate courses beyond the master's degree but less than a doctoral degree. This type of certificate is approved/reviewed by the IBHE.

**Degree Program:** A program which has specific requirements and number of credits, including a common core for all students seeking a particular degree. Degree programs are approved through a curricular process through the Illinois Board of Higher Education.

**Degree Student:** A student that has been admitted to a program leading to a degree.

End of Term: A file saved after the last day of classes. Off-campus enrollment is more accurate if counted at the end of term.

Fiscal Year: Includes summer sessions, fall, and spring semesters. For example, fiscal year 2005 includes information for summer 2004, fall 2004, and spring 2005.

Full-Time Enrollment: For graduate students nine or more credit hours per semester.

Graduate Record Examination (GRE): A national exam used for admission to many master's and all doctoral programs.

General Management Admission Test (GMAT): A test used for admission to the College of Business graduate programs.

Grade Point Average (GPA): The total number of grade points divided by the total graded semester hours attempted.

**Graduate Assistants:** Students working toward a graduate level degree that are hired by the University to teach, do research or fill office positions while continuing their education. A Graduate Assistant receives a monthly stipend and may also receive a tuition waiver.

Graduate Trustees' Tuition Waiver Awards: Are awarded on a competitive basis to students who show promise for success and have not received a fellowship or other award funding tuition costs.

**Headcount**: The count of each student enrolled at the University.

Major or Program: A combination of courses, including introductory, intermediate and advanced course work designating a student's primary area of specialization.

New Students: Students attending Illinois State University for the first time (Illinois State University baccalaureate recipients entering their first semester working on a second bachelor's degree are considered readmitted students).

**Non-Degree Seeking:** A student who has not been admitted to a program leading toward a degree; these include students-at-large and students working toward a non-IBHE approved/reviewed graduate certificate.

Non-Resident Alien: International students who are neither a citizen nor a permanent resident of the United States.

**On-and Off-Campus**: Students are considered "off-campus" if all of their courses meet at a location other than a University facility; they are considered an "on-campus" student if any or all of their courses meet at a University facility.

**Program Level:** A classification of programs indicating what type of degree or certification that student will earn.

Semester: A semester at Illinois State is the 16-week academic session offered each fall and spring. The summer session is not considered a semester.

Student-At-Large: A Graduate student who currently is not working toward a degree or has not been admitted officially to a graduate degree program.

Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL): An English exam required of international students prior to admission.


