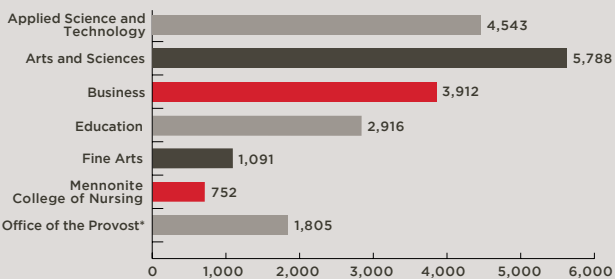

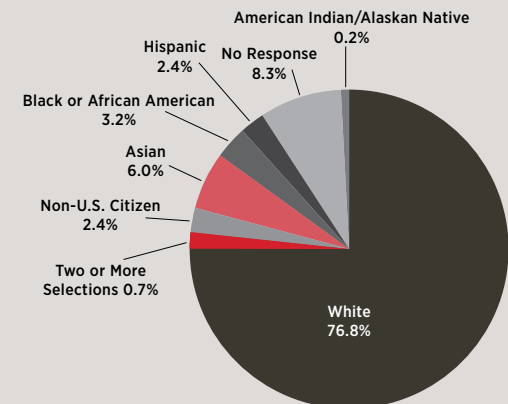

### Departmental Faculty by Race/Ethnicity

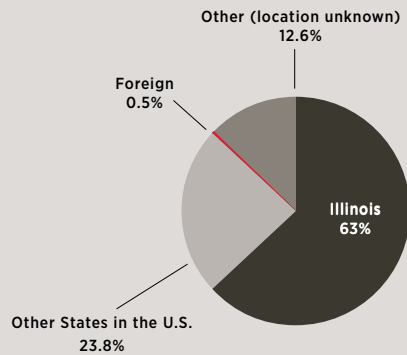
