

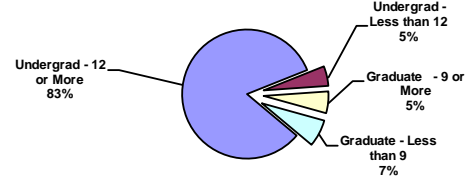

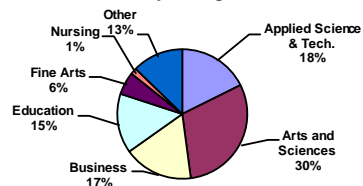

Enrollment by College Fall 2008

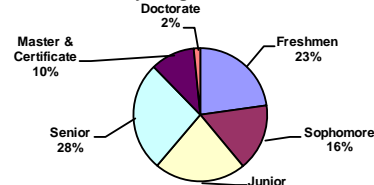

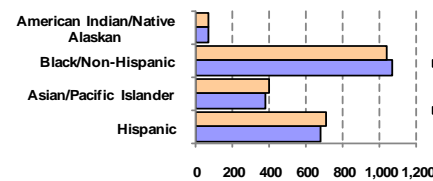

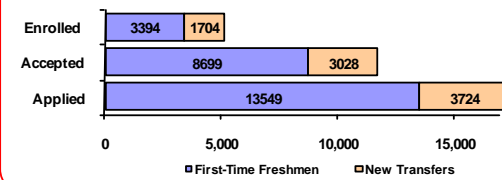

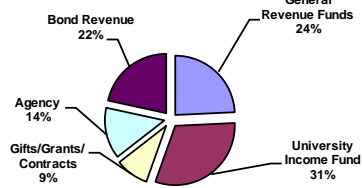

Operating Funds by Type (\$000)



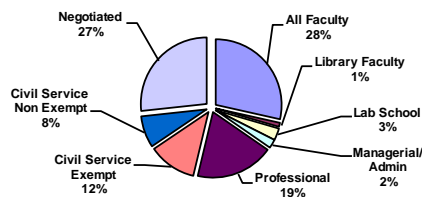

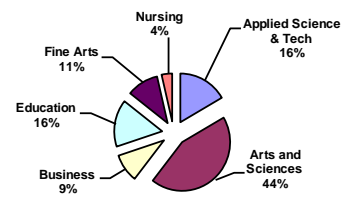
