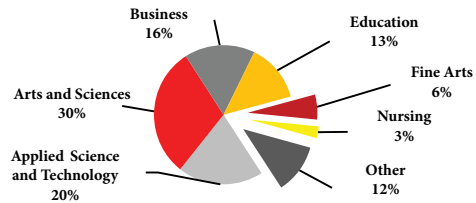

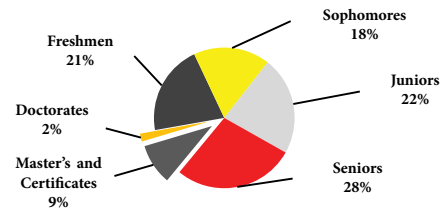

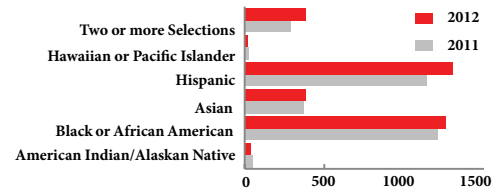

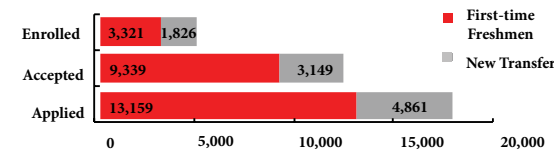

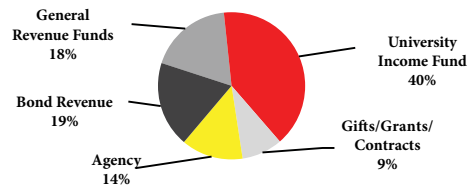

Fiscal Year 2013 Operating Funds by Type



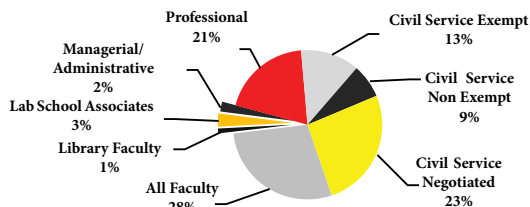

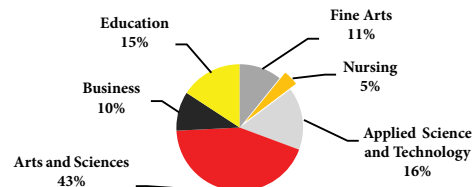

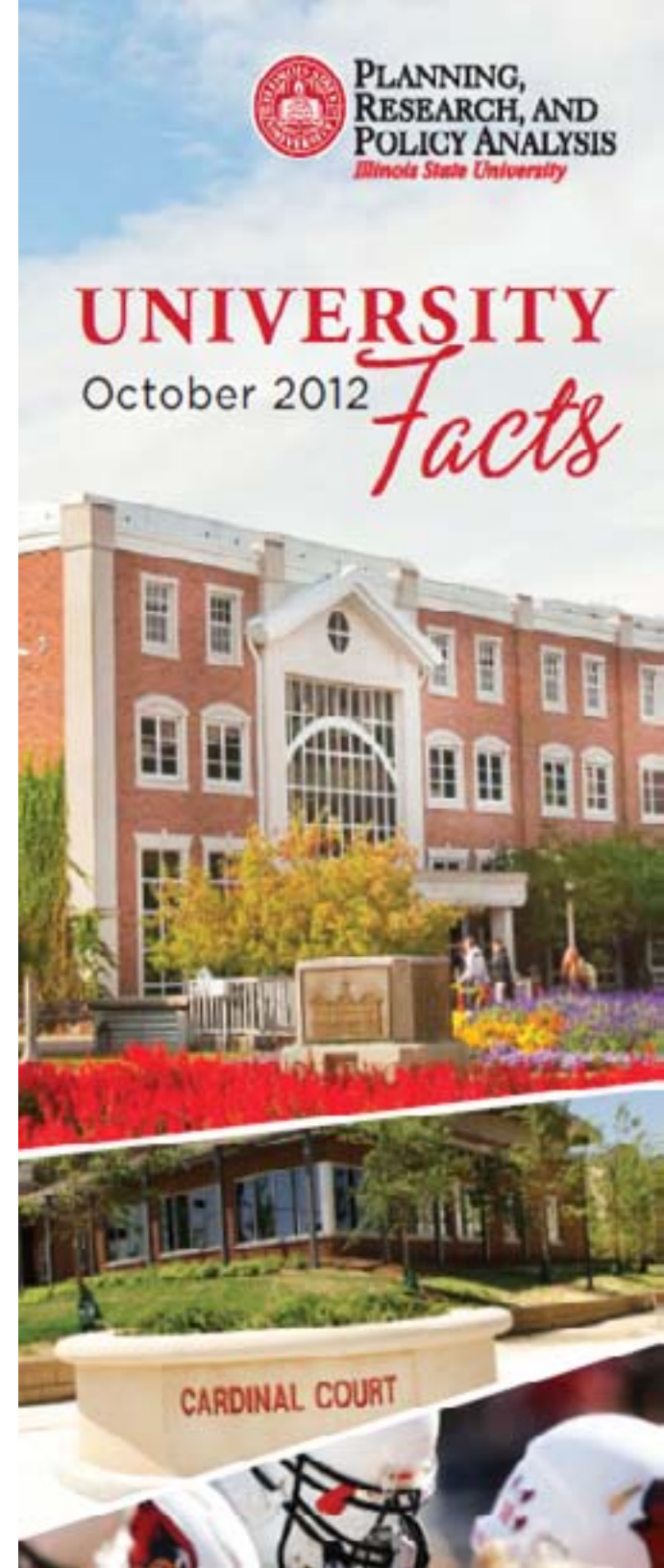
